TODAY'S ENVIRONMENT

- HEARTH ACT
 - CoC Interim Rule or 24 CFR Part 578
- FEDERAL APPROPRIATIONS
- NATIONAL COC PROGRAM COMPETITION
- EMPHASIS ON SYSTEM PERFORMANCE

PROCESS

- AGENCIES COMPLETE COC PROJECT APPLICATIONS FOR ALL HUD-FUNDED RENEWAL PROJECTS AND NEW/BONUS PROJECTS
- THEN, THE COLLABORATIVE APPLICANT AND FINANCE COLLECT AND REVIEW/RANK
- ALL APPROVED OR RECOMMENDED APPLICATIONS ARE PUT IN ESNAPS (FEDERAL/HUD SYSTEM)
- AFTERWARDS, ALL PROJECT APPLICATIONS AND COC APPLICATION ARE SUBMITTED AS ONE CONSOLIDATED APPLICATION TO HUD

IMPORTANT PROCESS NOTE

- THE PROJECT APPLICATIONS ARE DUE IN E-SNAPS 30 DAYS PRIOR TO DEADLINE
- THE COC CONSOLIDATED APPLICATION IS DUE TO HUD ON SEPTEMBER 18, 2018. OUR TARGET DATE IS SEPTEMBER 17, 2018.
- HUD MAY ISSUE UP TO TWO CONDITIONAL FUNDING ANNOUNCEMENTS

Similar to last year, if you have a start date in the first quarter of the year, you may need to plan ahead to continue operating your grant without drawing down money from HUD for a few months.

DEADLINES

- AUGUST 17, 2018 BY 12PM: APPLICANT PROJECT APPLICATION -SEND TO MATT.STEVENSON@LANSINGMI.GOV
- AUGUST 31, 2018 BY 5:00 PM: PROJECT APPLICATION FINAL DUE IN E-SNAPS.

This timeline has been established to comply with HUD requirements.

No Deadline extensions can be granted.

IMPORTANT CHANGES

- THE RENEWAL PROJECT APPLICATIONS FUNCTION SIMILARLY IN FY 2018 TO THE 2017 COMPETITION
 - Ability to import data from FY 2017
 - Screens will look different depending on whether project chooses to import data or not
- PREPOPULATED FORMS
 - HUD 2880
 - HUD 50070-Certification for Drug-Free Workplace
 - SF LLL Disclosure of Lobbying
- PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING PROJECTS
 - DedicatedPLUS option
 - Pending CoC Board Approval

NEW FOR 2018

Transition Grants – An existing renewable component (e.g. TH) can transition to another component (e.g., PH-RRH). Must use reallocation process to one of the eligible NEW project components: PH-PSH, PH-RRH, Joint TH and PH-RRH, dedicated HMIS or SSO-CE.

Consolidation - Can consolidate two or more eligible renewal projects (<4) into one project application. Prior to doing this, Applicant (City) should consult with local HUD field office to ensure each project is eligible to be consolidated, so inform us of your intent right away. Must be same recipient and same component.

Expansion - Renewal project applicant may: 1) submit a new project application to add units, beds, persons served or services to current operations. 2) request CoC funds to add to a homeless project funded from other sources. (cannot replace state/local funds)

Reallocation – Can shift funds in whole or in part from eligible renewal projects to create one or more new projects. This year, the CoC voted to reallocate Walnut Apts (\$105,870) ONLY. The 2018 NOFA allows CoCs to combine bonus and reallocation funding into a single project to fund eligible new components. Keep Supportive Services at 20% and admin at 6-8%.

Bonus (\$145,655) and DV Bonus (\$183,917) available for one or more new projects. See NOFA for details and eligibility. CoC can only submit one project application for each project type (PH-RRH, Joint TH and PH-RRH and SSO-CE) under DV Bonus.

COC PROJECT COMPONENTS 24 CFR 578.37

PH-PSH – housing without designated length of stay for those with disabilities, priority to CH, with supportive services.

PH-RRH – housing with supportive services for those with or without disabilities to move quickly into permanent housing. Short or medium-term rental assistance up to 24 mos.

Transitional Housing – housing to move participants to PH within 24 months.

Joint TH and PH-RRH – combines transitional housing and permanent housing-rapid rehousing in a single project. Requires Housing First approach and participants may only receive up to 24 mos of total assistance. (see V.C.3 of 2018 NOFA)

Dedicated HMIS – provides data collection and reporting for the CoC as a whole.

SSO-CE – Supportive Service Only grant may be used for building or leasing of a facility from which SS is provided. Currently only funding SSO for Coordinated Entry. (2017 NOFA reinforced in 2018 NOFA)
